Terms & Conditions

Family Benefits

Purpose: The Family Benefit is designed to support eligible employees in sharing the mountain experience with their families by providing discounted access to passes for their partners and dependent children. Encouraging quality family time, ensuring everyone can enjoy the perks of the mountain together.

Employment Type

Team Member Eligibility

Full Time or Part Time Team Members Eligible from commencement of contract with the ongoing criteria:

• Contracted Hours: Fulfil all contracted hours as specified in their employment agreement

Casual Team Members

Eligible after 12 months of continuous employment with the ongoing criteria:

- **Minimum Worked Hours:** Must work a minimum average of 20 hours per week over the preceding 12 months.
- Attendance & Availability: Demonstrates flexibility to work shifts to meet business demands.
- Eligibility is assessed annually.

Seasonal Team Members Seasonal refers to fixed term & casual team members working a minimum of 10 weeks per season.

Eligible upon commencing their 4th consecutive season with the ongoing criteria:

- Minimum Worked Hours: Meeting the minimum hours commitment during either summer or winter operations dependant on their role.
- Peak Period Coverage: Must be available during peak business periods and events.
- Shift Acceptance: Regularly accepts offered shifts.
- Eligibility is assessed seasonally

Please note that the family benefits pass is linked to your employment, which includes if you change employment status, receive a written warning, or have your employment suspended or terminated, the family benefit passes may be suspended or revoked.

Definitions

Partner:

A partner refers to a Married or De Facto Relationship. A de facto relationship outline in the Family Law Act requires that two people are living together on a genuine domestic basis for at least two years.

Dependant Child:

Refers to your dependant children under 18 years of age or your dependents under the age 21 years studying full time.

When to submit a replacement form

- When the terms and conditions are updated each team member will be required to submit an updated form to accept the new terms and conditions at the start of the next season.

- Seasonal employees must submit a new form each season



Winter Transport Initiatives

Thredbo offers 50% Bus Subsidy or \$200 Carpool Bonus to support staff in getting to work. As long as you meet the below eligibility, you can apply in September. Further information on the process will be posted closer to when applications are open.
