





### FACES OF THREDBO

#### FRANK PRIHODA

Long-time resident and local business owner, Frank Prihoda, was a beloved and iconic face of Thredbo. His story began in former Czechoslovakia in 1921. As a teen he developed a passion for skiing that continued throughout his lifetime. Aided by skis, a daring escape from Post-War Europe brought Frank Prihoda to Australia's shores in 1950. Shortly to follow were his sister, Sasha Nekvapil, and good friend Tony Sponar, both Czech ski champions. Though not an accomplished athlete in his native land, as an Australian Frank competed in the Cortina d'Ampezzo 1956 Winter Olympics in the Slalom and Giant Slalom



events. He continued to ski up until his 89th birthday, and by the grand old age of 101, had achieved renown as Australia's oldest living Olympian. Having passed away in 2022, Frank continues to be remembered as a loving neighbour, friend, and uncle, who had a way with words, an infectious zest for life, and a white subaru.



#### MRS. MITCHELL

The first woman to ski the western ranges of the Snowy
Mountains, Mrs. Elyne Mitchell, was also an
accomplished author. Her many books, including the
Silver Brumby novel series, have immortalised her love of
the mountains. At Thredbo, she found true
companionship amongst like-minded individuals.

#### SPONAR & ANTON

Who founded Thredbo? Czech ski champion and Snowy Hydro hydrographer Tony Sponar, or the short, noisy Austrian insurance broker Charles Anton? The debate may rage, but the fact remains: without the vision and commitment of both, Thredbo would likely not have existed.





Built in 1963, the Thredbo Alpine Hotel holds many secrets and stories, one of our favourites is the Lounge Bar Fire.

Opening weekend, Saturday June 10th 2000, a few of our guests indulged in a handful of martinis late into the evening and took it upon themselves to keep the fireplace alight. Suddenly the fire grew beyond control, and a groomer on mountain saw smoke billowing from the chimney.

Staff were able to evacuate everyone and save the treasured artwork you can see around you.

These days, we have a gas fireplace, so please, you indulge and we'll take care of the fire.
