8:30am 4hr Lesson Option: longer lesson duration for students to progress their skills on-snow.

Rate Hold on Value Season: Thredbo's state-of-the-art All-Weather Snowmaking System ensures reliable snow coverage on Friday Flat throughout June and September, giving school groups confidence their lessons and activities will go ahead as planned.

Resort Activity Day Options: for non-skiing and non-snowboarding groups to experience Thredbo or wrap up your School's on-snow trip with resort activities on their final day.

<u>School Holiday Blackout Period</u>: for 2026 the blackout period is just two weeks (6 July - 17 July) Note: limited availability for 29 June - 3 July

THREDBO SCHOOL GROUP PRODUCT OUTLINE

1. STUDENT LIFT & LESSON PRODUCT

Thredbo offers students a lift and lesson school group product, which includes:

- Full day lift pass, with duration options of 1-Day, or up to 5-Days (Monday to Friday only)
- Mandatory daily morning lesson, 4hr duration at 8:30am or 2hr duration at either 8:30am or 10:30am
- Mandatory Day 1 afternoon lesson for all student lift and lesson school group products (start time 1:30pm)

Schools can elect to add-on additional products, outlined below:

- Additional afternoon lessons from Day 2 onwards, 2hr duration at 1.30pm (Day 1 included in all programs)
- Ski or Snowboard Equipment Rental (complimentary helmets included)
 - On-site equipment storage lockers available as Thredbo rental equipment add-on
- Insulated Jacket and Pant clothing package rental
 - Purchase Packs options of goggle only, glove only or goggle & glove packages (unable to be rented)
- Lunch: hot meal and drink with a 50min reserved area booking (location Friday Flat Bistro)
- Thredbo Alpine Coaster: 1 x ride per day (note: not an exclusive booking)
- Thredbo Leisure Centre: access to Sports Hall or Pool/Slide (Mission Inflatable available as pool add-on)

2. TEACHER LIFT ONLY OR LIFT & ADULT LESSON PRODUCT

Thredbo offers School Group Teachers a lift only or lift & adult lesson product, <u>receiving 2 teachers free of charge</u> (FOC) for every 10 paying students (note: some add-ons are excluded from the FOC allocation)

- Lift pass duration matches student's lift & lesson product duration
- Teachers/Supervisors with School Groups can attend student lessons with the lift only option:
 - This attendance in the student lesson is in a shadow capacity, no instruction provided to the teacher
 - Teachers are required to be above the riding ability of the student lesson they are shadowing
- Teachers/Supervisors can elect the lift & adult lesson product (free when within the FOC ratio of 2:10):
 - Adult lesson: 2hr duration at either 9:15am or 11:20am
 - Please note this is at a different time and meeting location to the student lessons
 - Due to the different start times between adult and student lessons, teachers/supervisors may need to leave the adult lesson early to resume supervision at the conclusion of the student lesson

3. RESORT ACTIVITY DAY PRODUCT (NON-SKIING & NON-SNOWBOARDING SCHOOL GROUP)

Thredbo wants your school group to maximise their time in resort. The below resort activity options are aimed at 1 Day tripper School Groups looking for alternative activities outside of the Thredbo Skiing/Snowboarding program or for schools already booked the Skiing/Snowboarding school program and want an addition morning/day.

- 1 Day activities can be selected from: Gondola Scenic Lift, Alpine Coaster Rides, Thredbo Leisure Centre, Lunch and Clothing or Disc Golf Rental
- Teacher FOC passes matching student passes are offered at the 2:10 ratio for every 10 paying students
 - o FOC allocation is not valid for add-ons of lunch, mission inflatable and disc golf
- Depending on the number of students, schools may need to split into smaller groups to be accommodated and efficiently progress through each selected activity
- Activity times need to be adhered to, and access will not be allowed outside of the allocated times

Please note for Resort Activity Groups: when visiting the resort for sightseeing or on a resort activity day, ski runs are designated for active Snowsports use only (skiing or snowboarding). Entry onto ski or snowboard runs by individuals not participating in Snowsports creates a significant safety risk, as these areas involve high-speed travel and may include participants with limited ability to avoid obstacles. For your safety and the safety of others, non-skiing/snowboarding guests must remain clear of all marked ski runs. Resort staff may request individuals to relocate if they are found in breach of this condition.

THREDBO SCHOOL GROUP IMPORTANT INFORMATION & UPDATES

The information provided below is required to be read in conjunction with the rates above and Thredbo Winter 2026 School Group Booking Terms and Conditions. The below updates will apply to all School Groups – no exceptions.

4. WINTER 2026 BOOKING PROCESS

4.1. Booking Requests

- Please read the product outline and booking terms & conditions prior to submitting a booking request
- All booking requests must be completed via the provided online form (available via Thredbo Website)
 - No other booking requests via email or phone will be considered

NOTE: Resort Activity (non-skier and non-snowboarder groups) booking requests open early 2026 via a separate form

4.2. Booking Process Lesson Priority Allocation

- Schools who previously booked with Thredbo in Winter 2025 will secure lesson allocation spots initially, and on a first served basis according to booking request submission
- Booking requests for returning schools will need to be submitted by 4 December 2025
 - After this date, allocation spots will be based on booking request submission first served basis

4.3. Deposit Payment

- Booking confirmation will be subject to a paid \$200 non-refundable deposit
- Deposit Payment will be due <u>7 days</u> after the email date of the provided booking confirmation
- If no payment has been received by the set date outlined by Thredbo Groups, the confirmed lesson allocation spot is forfeited, and allocation is subject to availability
- If groups cancel their booking, the paid \$200 is forfeited and cannot be reallocated

5. STUDENT LESSONS - EXTENDED MORNING LESSON DURATION & DAY 1 AFTERNOON LESSON

5.1. Extended Morning Lesson Option Available

- *NEW* for Winter 2026, Thredbo will offer the option to select an extended 4hour lesson product
- The extended daily lesson duration will be 4hours at 8.30am to 12.30pm (if selected)
- Schools can add-on afternoon lessons to ensure students are in supervised lessons for majority of the day (example: select 8:30am-12:30pm 4hr morning lesson, then 1:30pm-3:30pm 2hr afternoon lesson)
- Teachers are required to resume student supervision from 12.30pm and when students are outside of lessons

5.2. Day 1 Mandatory Afternoon Lesson for all School Group Lift & Lesson Products

- Day 1 afternoon lesson will be included in all school group Lift & Lesson packages
- Regardless of the School's State location and to provide a straightforward integration of this product change,
 Day 1 afternoon lesson cost is incorporated in all School Groups Lift & Lesson products.
- Thredbo will require all schools to attend the included Day 1 second 2-hour lesson (most likely the afternoon start time 1.30pm), in addition to their mandatory morning lesson.

5.3. Add-On Lessons (1.30pm from Day 2)

- Schools can add on additional 1.30pm lessons from Day 2 (providing students further supervised lesson time)

5.4. Student and Teacher Data Form & Student Disciplines and Ability Levels

- Thredbo Groups will provide outlined explanations required to nominate the most accurate ability level
- More details will be provided when the Student and Teacher data form is provided early 2026
- Student numbers per discipline (ski or snowboard) are required in the booking request form to allow Thredbo to accurately allocate lesson times based on instructor numbers

5.5. Pre-Allocation of Lesson Classes

- Our Snowsports team will allocate students into lesson classes within the 1:10 ratio class size
- Lesson class allocation is based on student's allocated discipline and ability level, as nominated in the student and teacher data form, with these lesson classes provided to schools from Thredbo
- At least 3 days prior to arrival schools can suggest required amendments to enhance class cohesion

6. TEACHER/SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITIES

6.1. Lift Restrictions Resulting from Lesson Non-Compliance

- Non-compliance in lesson participation, including the Day 1 mandatory afternoon lesson will result in the restriction of lift access for the duration of lessons, or an extended period determined by Thredbo
- Lift access will be restricted for students who do not actively and respectfully participate in lessons
- Teacher/Supervisor lift access may also be restricted resulting from student non-compliance
- Students and Teachers/Supervisors will fall under Thredbo's management of non-compliance available here

6.2. Teacher/Supervisor Responsibility & FOC

- Teachers are responsible for students riding responsibly outside of their lesson time and maintaining the group's overall respect towards staff and guests
- Teachers are responsible for student lesson drop off and collection at the School Group meeting area
- For every 10 paying students, 2 teachers will be Free of Charge (FOC) for lift & lesson packages

7. BLACKOUT PERIOD

- Schools wishing to book during the Blackout period of Mon, 6 July Fri, 17 July or on the weekends will be able to do so via the Thredbo Online Shop when retail product becomes available (not via Thredbo Groups)
- Pricing will be at the retail rate available when purchasing online (no school group pricing available)
- Lessons will also need to be booked online (not via Thredbo Groups)
 - o Please note lessons sell out during this time and availability will be as per the online shop
- Weekends remain a blackout period for the school group program during the whole winter season

8. ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

Thredbo requests Teachers/Supervisors incorporate the below into the schools' briefing prior to their Snowsports trip as part of understanding the <u>Alpine Responsibility Code</u> and Thredbo's management of non-compliance.

- As per the NSW guidelines for Teacher/Supervisors: reasonable steps must be taken to demonstrate that students understand and will adhere to the Alpine Responsibility Code
- Terms used in this Alpine Responsibility Code can be found by reading the <u>Winter Lift Pass</u> Contract for Winter Lift & Resort Access Terms and Conditions. Schools agree to these Terms and Conditions as part of the completed Student and Teacher data form.

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

Skiers/snowboarders must observe the Alpine Responsibility Code and ski/ride in a safe manner at all times. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of skiing/snowboarding privileges.

OBSERVE THE CODE AND SHARE WITH OTHERS THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A GREAT EXPERIENCE

If you are found to have acted in a Dangerous Manner or to be in a closed area, your Pass may be suspended or cancelled by Thredbo as outlined below:

8.1. Date-Based Lift Pass

- First Instance: Cancellation of remaining validity of Date-Based Lift Pass. Pass Holder is Suspended from using and receiving the benefits of the Pass for a period of 7 consecutive days
- Second Instance: Cancellation of remaining validity of Date-based Lift Pass. Pass Holder is Suspended from using and receiving the benefits of the Pass for a period of 30 consecutive days
- Third Instance: Cancellation of remaining validity of the Date Based Lift Pass. Pass Holder is Suspended from using and receiving the benefits of the Pass for the remainder of the winter season

9. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please note by booking through Thredbo Groups you are agreeing to our Group Booking Terms and Conditions and any additional terms and conditions on behalf of all participants in your group.
