



## Environment Week - Second Hand Ski Sale

### Event Details

Members of the public and are invited to sell pre-loved ski and snowboard equipment and winter wear, including skis, snowboards, poles, boots and outerwear, at the Secondhand Sale.

- If selling hardware (Skis/boots etc) only items that are under 10 years old will be accepted.
- Please clean your items before bringing them to the Sale.
- Stall holders will gain access to the Kosci Room from 12:30pm on the day. Drop off and load areas are restricted to the 15 minute area in front of the Keller.
- Any unsold items must be packed down and collected after the sale on Wednesday 15th July by 7pm. Leftover jackets in acceptable condition will be donated to XTM's initiative, Heat the Homeless.

### Stallholder Terms & Conditions

#### 1. Bookings and Payment

- All stallholders MUST apply to attend. All application forms are to be completed online via the booking form.
- Stall fees must be paid in full prior to the sale.
- All stall fees are non-refundable; however, bookings may be transferred to another seller with prior written notice to Kosciuszko Thredbo Pty Ltd (KT).

## **2. Stallholder Responsibilities**

- Sellers are responsible for bringing and managing their equipment (e.g. clothing racks, mirrors, signage, EFTPOS machines, cash float)
- Stallholders are responsible for keeping their items, displays, and personal belonging within the allocated stall space.
- Sellers are required to complete setup prior to market opening and pack-down within one hour of market closing.
- Stallholders are solely responsible for all sales and transactions (cash, PayPal, Apple Pay, bank transfer, EFTPOS etc.), and remediation of disputes.

## **3. Safety and Conduct**

- Stallholders are NOT PERMITTED to sell: offensive, illegal or counterfeit goods or any items associated with illegal drug use, weapons, or any manufactured goods that do not comply with current Australian safety standards.

## **4. Liability and Insurance**

- By participating, stallholders accept responsibility for their stall and any associated risks (including but not limited to loss, theft, damage, injury).
- KT's public liability insurance covers the market event, however stallholders remain responsible for their own goods, equipment, and sales.

## **5. Market Management**

- KT reserves the right to refuse entry or remove stallholders not complying with these Terms and Conditions.
- Allocation of a stall site is at the discretion of KT.
- Stallholders are required to follow venue rules, safety directions, and directions given by KT staff managing the event.
